The key considerations include:

Principle of the development & design/layout:

- the general scale of the development and spatial layout and arrangement of the wide mix of dwelling types proposed are considered to be acceptable.

Ecology:

- Preliminary Ecological Appraisal (PEA) required.
- Assess the potential impact of the development upon the Carmarthen Bay and Estuaries Special Area of Conservation (SAC), and SSSI.
- Tree survey required to inform layout, access and landscaping.
- Green Infrastructure Statement to be submitted.
